

The Maricopa Express Transit operates THREE types of service:

Comet the Local Circulator

Bus will deviate up to ¼ mile to pick up passengers unable to get to a bus stop. Same day reservations are accepted.

Monday - Friday
8:00 am – 5:00 pm

- Circulating vehicle within city limits
- Uses bus stops at key locations
- Monday through Friday
- 8:00 am – 5:00 pm
- Fare: \$.50 per boarding
- No reservation needed
- Open to the general public and ADA compliant

Local Dial-A-Ride

Monday - Friday
9:00 am – 5:00 pm

- Curbside service within City limits
- Fare: \$1.00 per one-way trip
- 24-hour reservation is required
- Open to the general public and ADA compliant
- Same day reservation subject to availability

Regional Dial-A-Ride to Medical Facilities

Service to Chandler Regional Hospital

Tuesday Only

Service to Casa Grande Banner

Thursday Only

Both Service Offer:

- Location drop-off/pick up any medical facility within a five-mile radius from hospitals
- Buses begin curbside pick up at 9:00 am
- Last pick up out of Maricopa is at 10:00 am
- Last pick up back to Maricopa is at 3:00 pm
- Buses return to Maricopa by 5pm
- Fare: \$3.00 round trip
- 24-hour reservation required
- Open to the general public and ADA compliant

The Maricopa Express Transit

Passenger Rules of Conduct

- Shirts and shoes are required
- Eating, drinking, and smoking or alcoholic beverages are not allowed
- You may bring your drink on the bus if it is in an approved, covered plastic container
- Firearms, weapons, caustic or flammable materials are not allowed
- Service animals trained to assist persons with disabilities are welcome
- Fighting, throwing, pushing, playing loud audio devices, rough behavior, shouting, and/or vulgar or offensive language is not permitted
- Talking on your cell phone is allowed. However, be respectful and keep the volume to a minimum
- If you must stand, move towards the back to allow other riders to board. Stay behind the yellow line
- Gasoline-powered bicycles, scooters, and skate boards are not allowed on the bus or bike rack. Non-powered skateboards or scooters are allowed
- Do not litter or create unsanitary conditions
- Do not damage transit property and report acts of vandalism to the bus operator
- A responsible person* must accompany children under the age of eight on the COMET
- A responsible person* must make the reservations and accompany children under the age of 14 on the Dial-A-Ride service

* A responsible person is defined as one who can directly control and supervise the child such as a guardian or parent

All curbside pick up services require a 24-hour reservation, with 48-hours preferred. Same day reservations are subject to availability. Reservations can be made up to 14-days in advance.

When calling, please have the following information ready to give to the dispatcher:

- Address where you wish to be picked up
- The address where you are going
- The time you need to be picked up and
- The time you need to be at your destination
- Your phone number
- If you will use a mobility device or service animal
